Congratulations to all players.

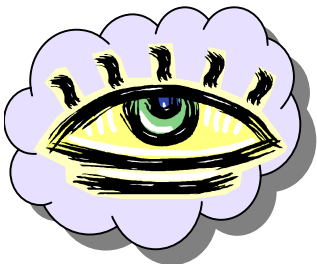
